Award Descriptions

Greek Life Awards:

Greek Life Man of the Year Award

This award recognizes individuals who represents his chapter, organization, and/or the St. Louis Greek NPHC community through the values of Scholarship, Service, Leadership and Brotherhood/Sisterhood. This man exemplifies the true meaning of being a member of a Greek letter organization.

Greek Life Woman of the Year Award

This award recognizes individuals who represents her chapter, organization, and/or the St. Louis Greek NPHC community through the values of Scholarship, Service, Leadership and Brotherhood/Sisterhood. This woman person exemplifies the true meaning of being a member of a Greek letter organization.

Greek Life Chapter of the Year Award

This award is presented to the chapter who has excelled in service to the HSSU and St. Louis community. This chapter is awarded because of their demonstration of overall success in the areas of scholarship, philanthropy, and integrity. This chapter has demonstrated as a group the values of scholarship, service, leadership and sisterhood/brotherhood.

Greek Life Outstanding Community Service Award

This award is presented to the Chapter for rendering outstanding community service to the HSSU and St. Louis community and surrounding areas. **Documentation must be on file or submitted. A minimum of two projects/service within the academic year.**

Individual & Group Awards

Outstanding Student Leader of the Year Award

This award is for a student recognized by peers, faculty and/or staff as being especially dedicated to both scholastic and extra-curricular activities. This student has made outstanding contributions to campus wide co-curricular programs and displayed positive leadership in and out of the classroom. Nominees must have a minimum of a 2.75 cumulative GPA.

Outstanding Student Athlete Leader of the Year Award

This award recognizes a student-athlete that has had a positive impact on the athletic community through his or her sportsmanship, leadership and teamwork.

Outstanding International Student Leader of the Year Award

This award recognizes an international student leader that has been actively involved through leadership activities, clubs and organizations, volunteerism and community service.

Outstanding RA of the Year Award

The RA of the Year Award recognizes the Resident Advisor who, through effective programming and cultivation of meaningful relationships with his/her residents, has developed exceptional community on his/her floor. Nominee must have served as an RA for both fall 2018 AND spring 2019 semesters.

Silent Impact Award

This award is given to a student who has served his or her organization or Harris-Stowe in an unassuming and quiet manner. This award is for a student who has not yet held a leadership role, but through a commitment of time and energy, he or she has made an impact.

Outstanding Student Organization of the Year Award

This award recognizes an organization that has positively influenced Harris-Stowe State University and the greater community through exceptional programming, leadership, activities, goal attainments and development of positive visions for the future. The winning organization must have demonstrated its commitments to the University's and organizational missions.

Outstanding Student Organization Advisor of the Year Award

This award is for an advisor that went above and beyond the requirements of the advisor position. The advisor provided consistent service and guidance to the students in their organization while serving as a role model. The nominee must be listed as the official advisor or co-advisor of the organization.

Exceptional Service to Students Award: Faculty

This award is for a HSSU faculty member (**professor**) who shows commitment and devotion to mentoring and caring for students; consistent and extraordinary guidance and professional support; provides special attention and mentoring to others they worked with, regardless of status or setting. This faculty member has demonstrated an exceptional commitment to student learning within the classroom and has dramatically influenced the lives of students in a positive way.

Exceptional Service to Students Award: Staff

This award is for a HSSU **staff** member who shows commitment and devotion to mentoring and caring for students; consistent and extraordinary guidance and professional support; provides special attention and mentoring to others they worked with, regardless of status or setting. This staff member has demonstrated an exceptional commitment to student learning outside of the classroom and has dramatically influenced the lives of students in a positive way.

Pillars of the Community Award (4)

This award is presented to a student organization or an individual student that makes service to their/his or her community a priority. This award will be given to an organization or student that has made an impact on the campus or community, and is serving as a positive role model, boosting courage, spirit and hope in other individuals.

Student Engagement Awards for Programming

Collaborative Event Award

This award recognizes the outstanding program of two or more groups or organizations brought together to achieve a common goal, working in partnership. This award highlights the specific program/event in which the collaboration took place for.

Outstanding Community Service Award

The award recognizes the program organized to increase the community involvement of HSSU students. (Documentation must be on file or submitted, minimum of two service projects/service within the academic year.)
