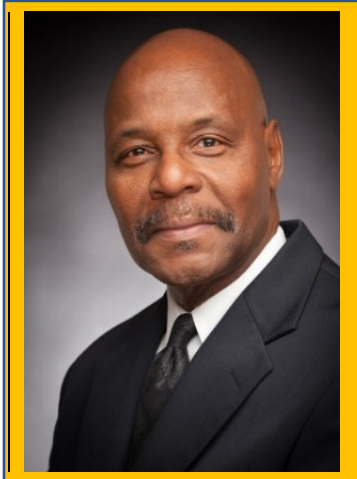

Biography: Dr. Charles E. Sykes serves as Assistant Dean and Associate Professor for Harris-Stowe State University, a historically black college and university in St. Louis, Mo. He joined the faculty of Harris-Stowe in 2004. For almost a decade, through his teachings, research, and service, Dr. Sykes has produced high academic achievement amongst the student body while imparting a good foundation of knowledge in his chosen fields of management, finance, ethics, and most-importantly, community service to the University and its' many constituents.
