Dear Harris-Stowe Family:

Yesterday the City of St. Louis and St. Louis County announced that their stay-at-home orders are extended until further notice, with an expected status update in mid-May. In response, Harris-Stowe State University is extending its work from home orders through May 15. Only individuals who are essential to the University's ongoing operations can remain physically on site. While we will continue to take into consideration advice from City and State agencies, all employees should anticipate returning to campus Monday, May 18.

The William L. Clay Sr. Early Childhood Development Center will also remain closed until May 15 and reopen for on-site childcare services on Monday, May 18, at 6:00 a.m. Parents and caregivers will not be billed for childcare services while the Center is closed.

The health and safety of our students, faculty, staff and entire community remain our highest priority. Thank you for your patience and flexibility as we continue to "flatten the curve" and slow the spread of COVID-19.
