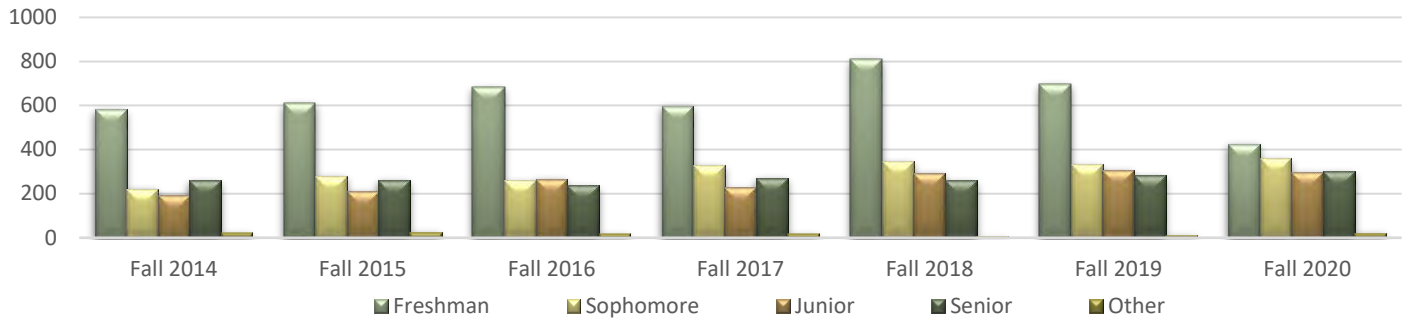

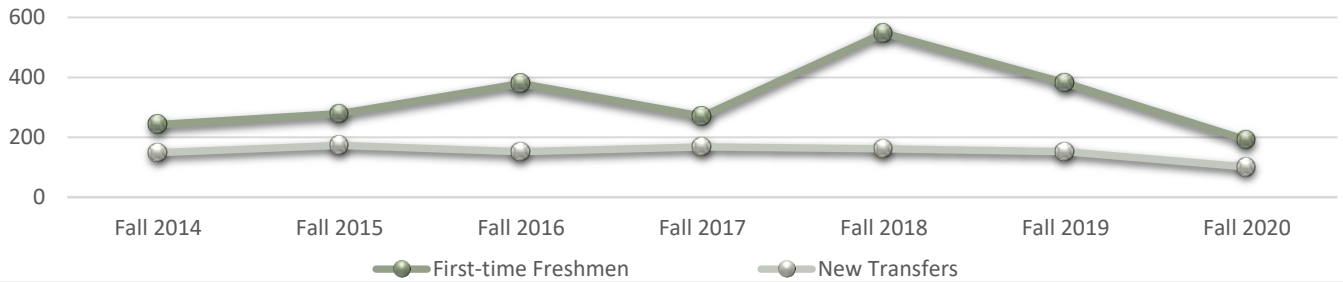

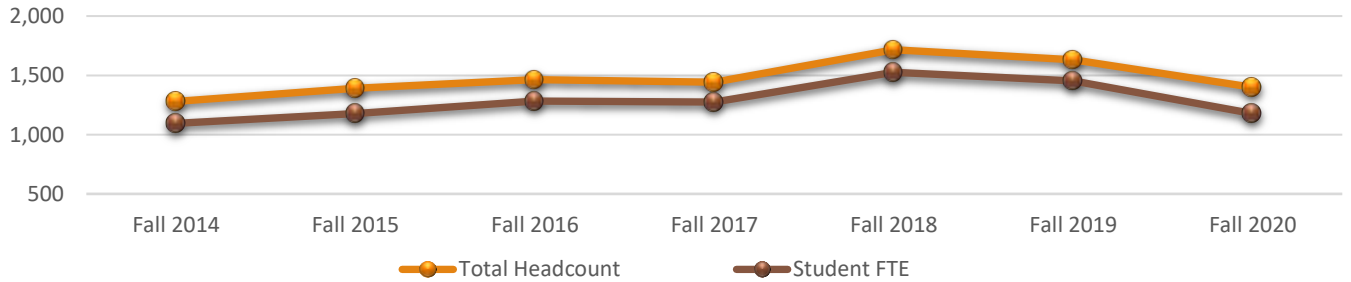
Fall Enrollment by Classification



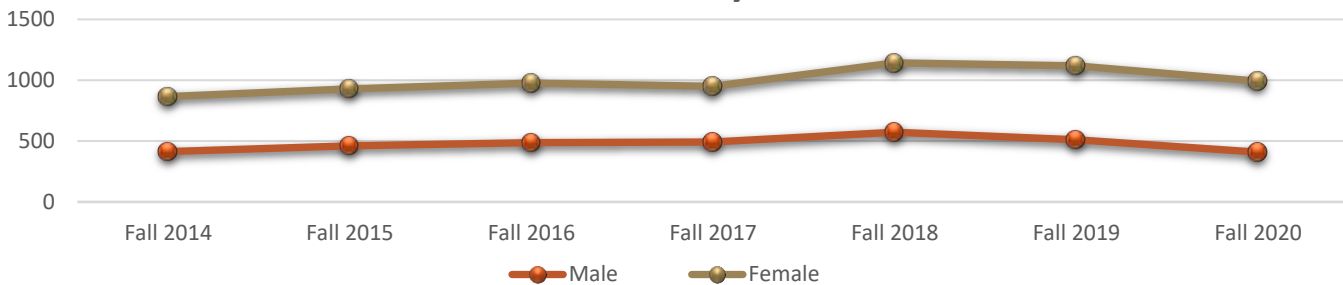
Fall Enrollment: New Students



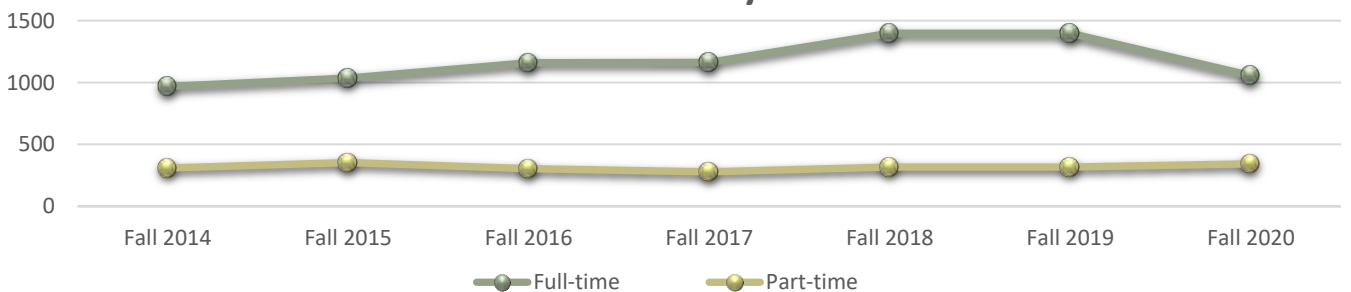
Fall Enrollment and FTE



Fall Enrollment by Gender



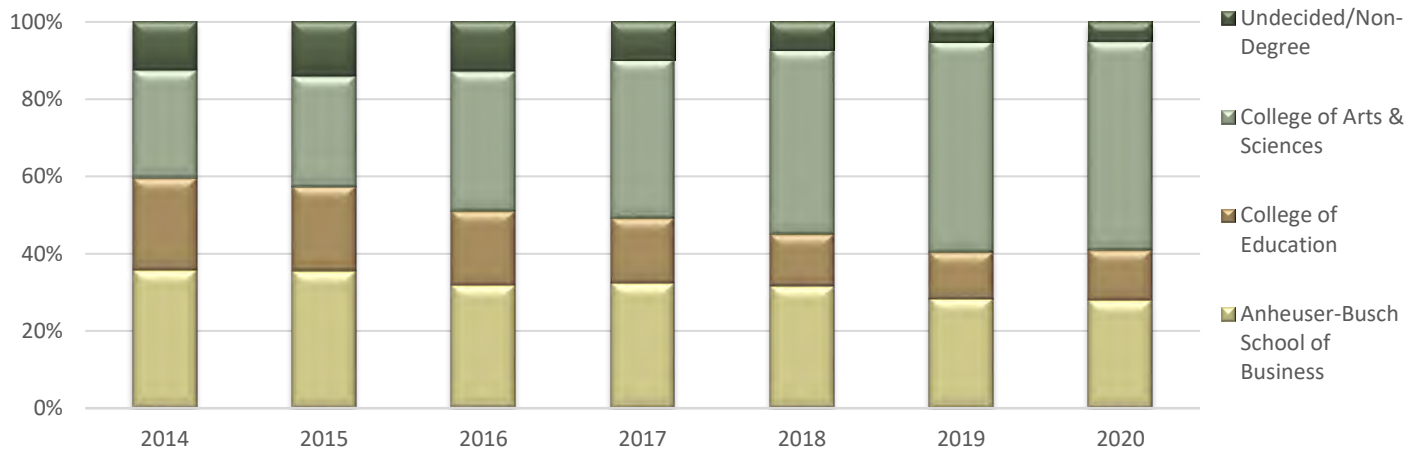
Fall Enrollment by Status



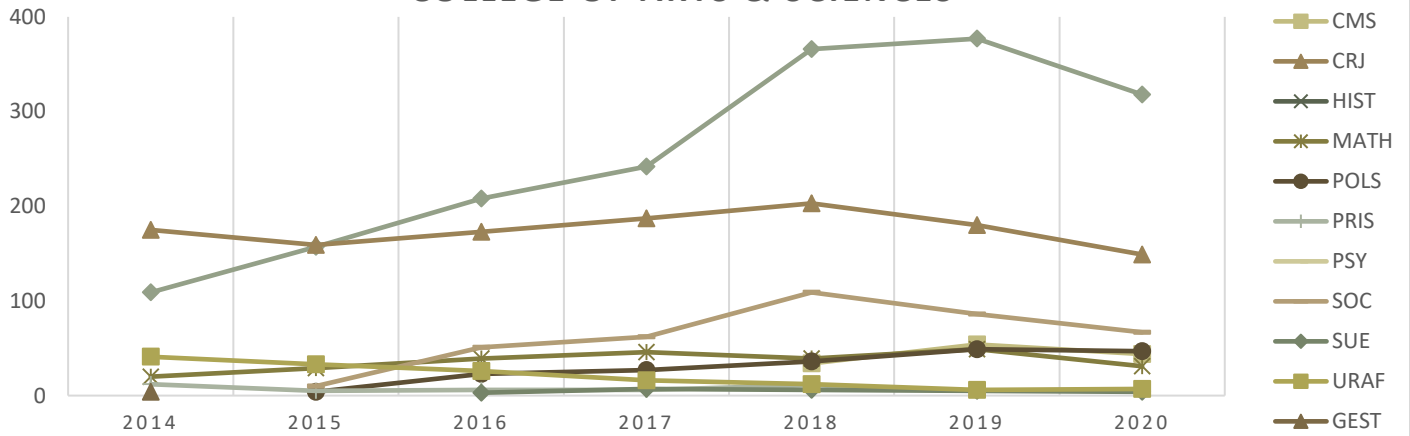

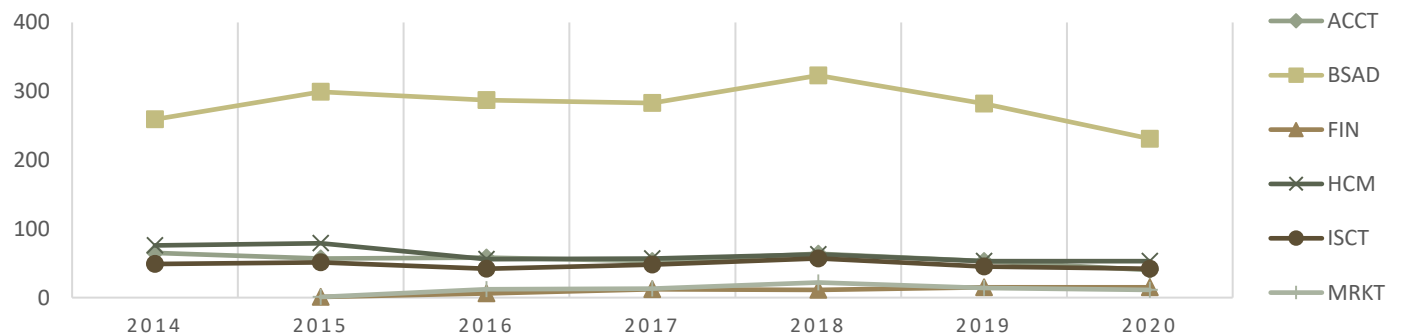
Enrollment Breakdown by College/School



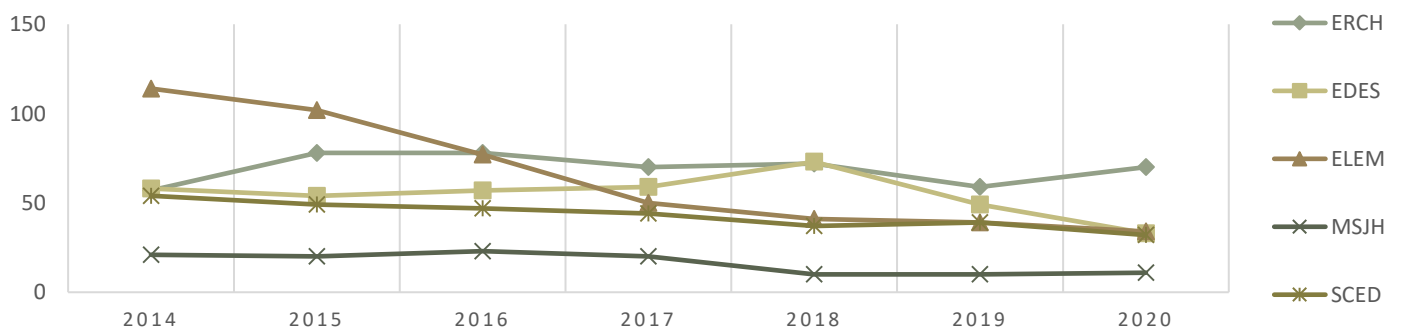

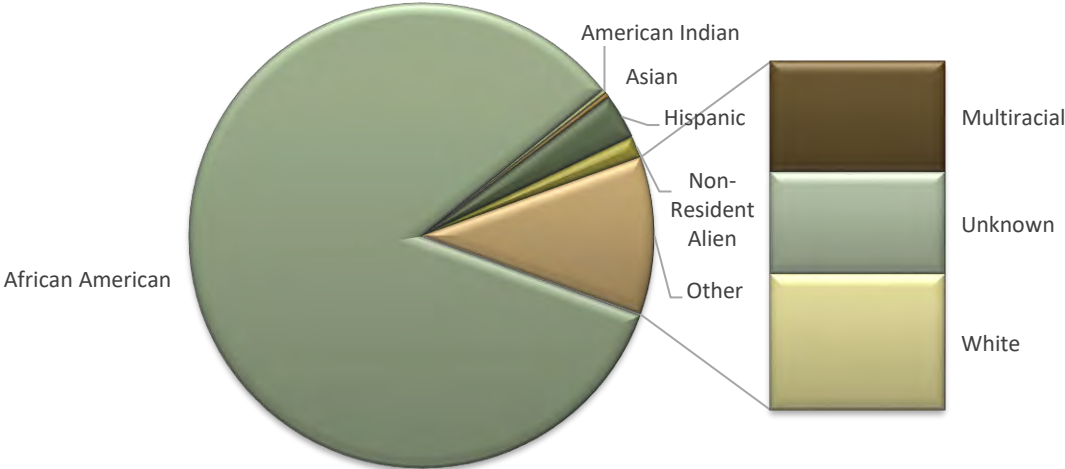

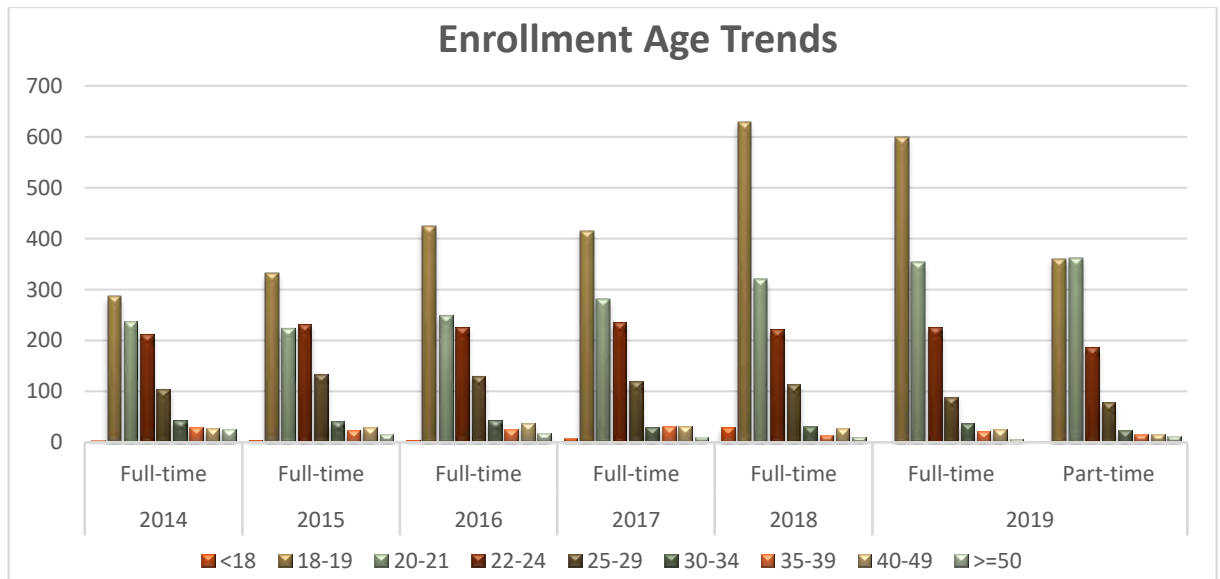
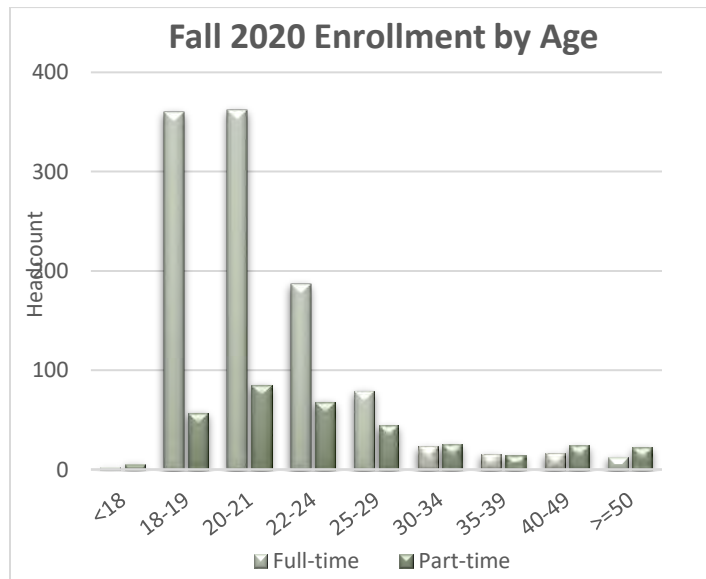
Fall 2020 Student Body by Race/Ethnicity

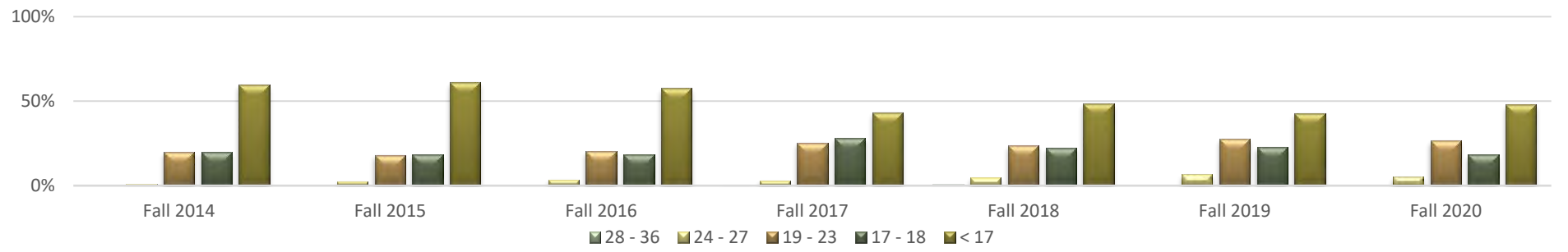

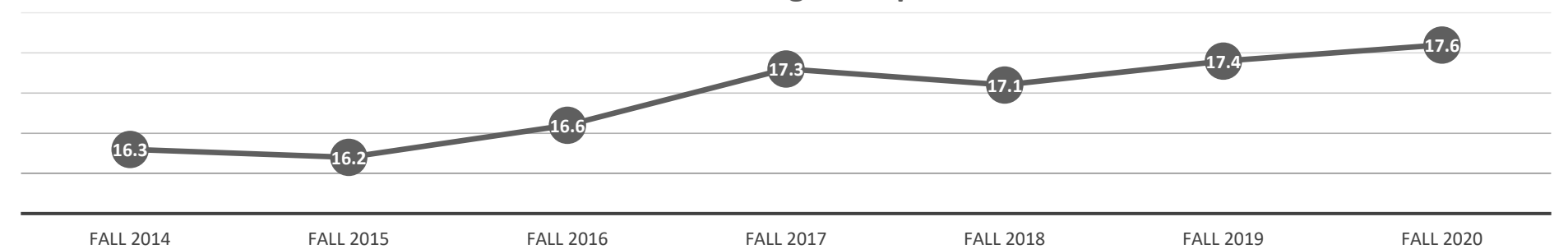

First-time, Full-time Transfer Retention

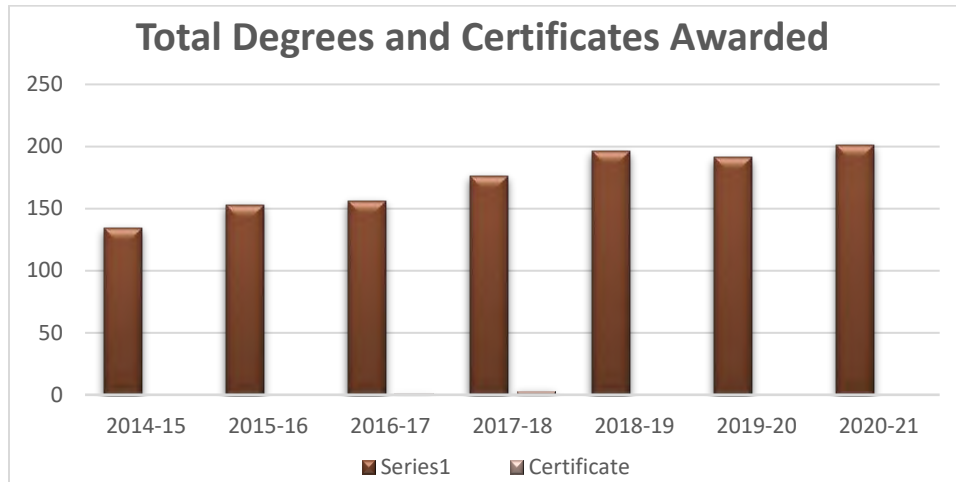


First-time, Part-time Transfer Retention



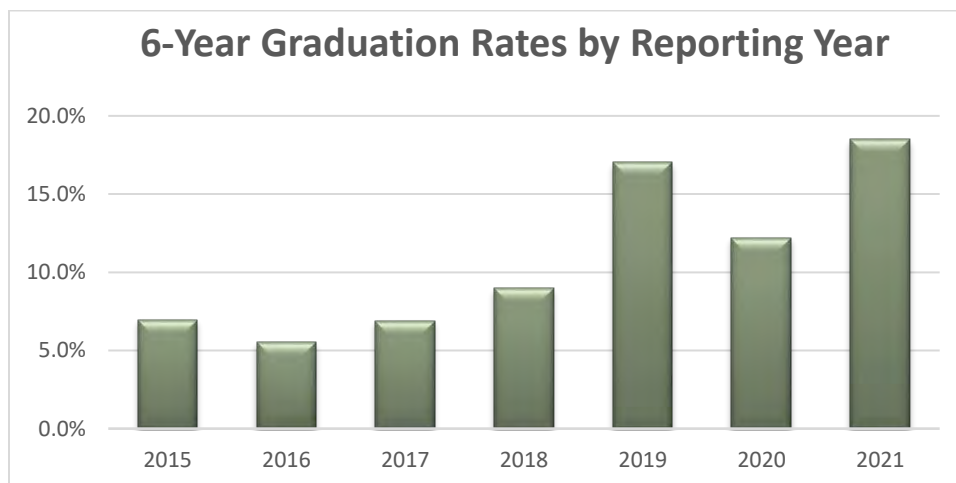

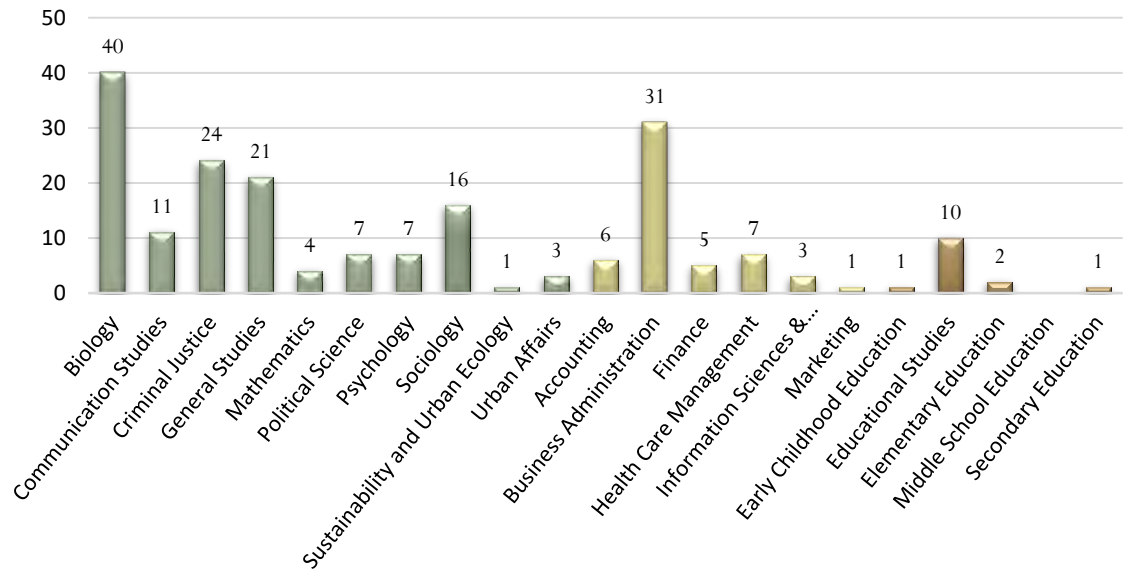
Degrees Conferred by Division



2020-2021 Bachelor Degrees Awarded by College



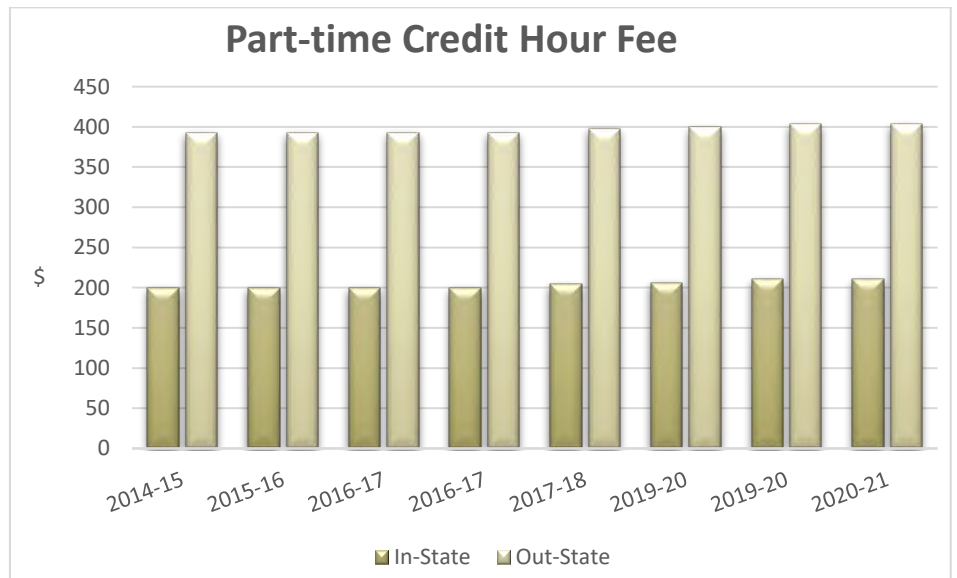
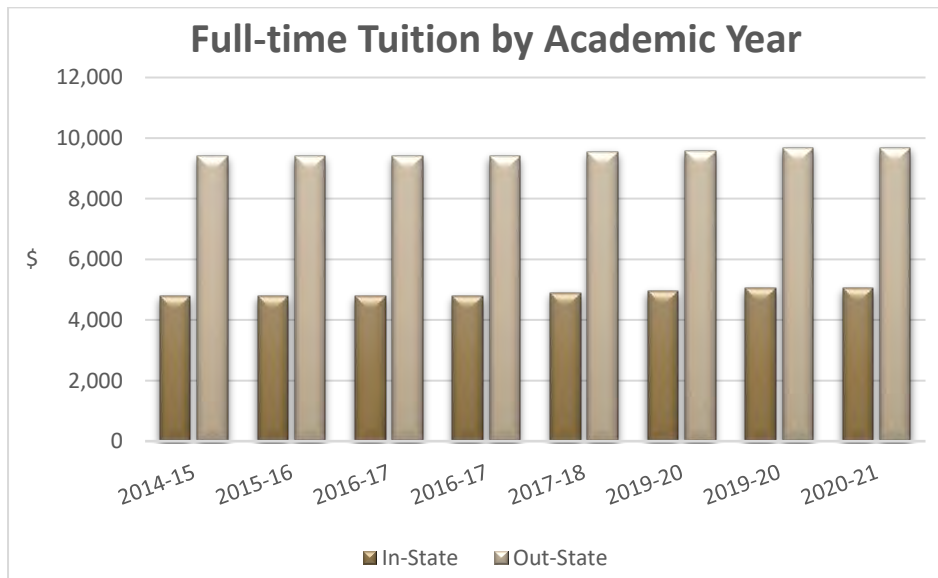
