




## Enrollment Breakdown by College/School









## Fall 2020 Student Body by Race/Ethnicity











### First-time, Full-time Transfer Retention







**6-Year Graduation Rates by Reporting Year**






## Degrees Conferred by Division

2020-2021 Bachelor Degrees Awarded by Major







**Unduplicated Headcount and Financial Aid**







