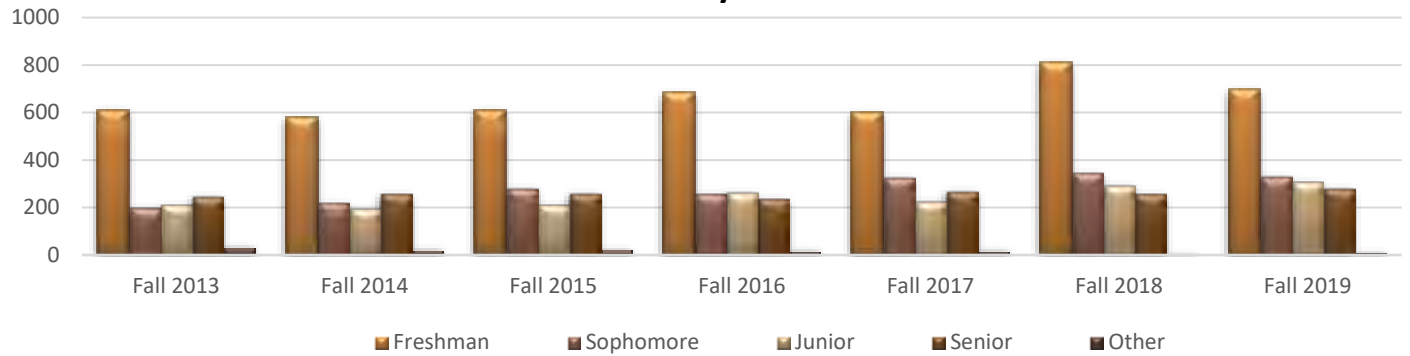

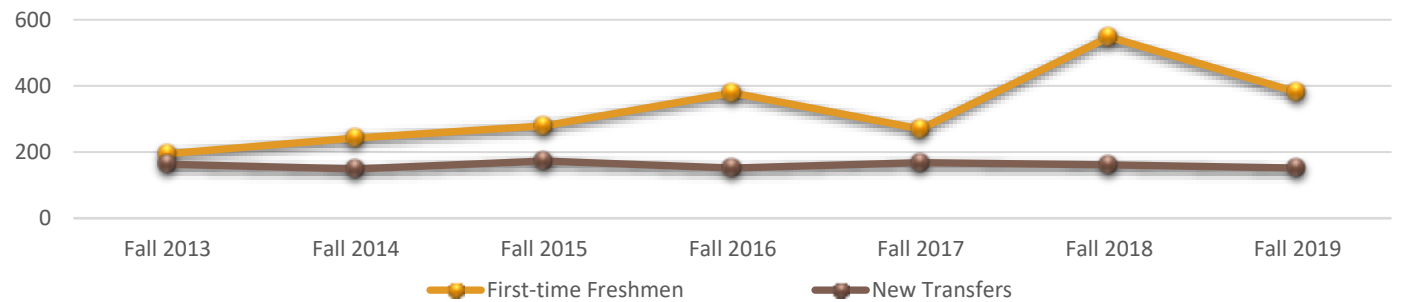

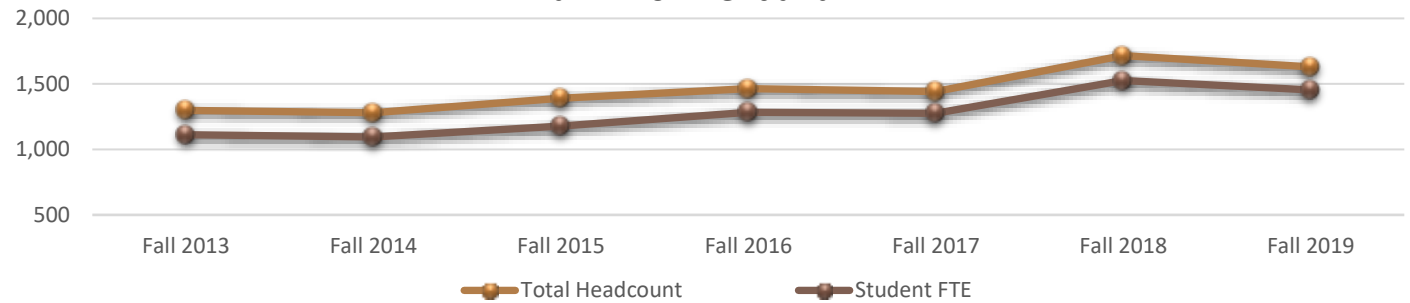
Fall Enrollment by Classification



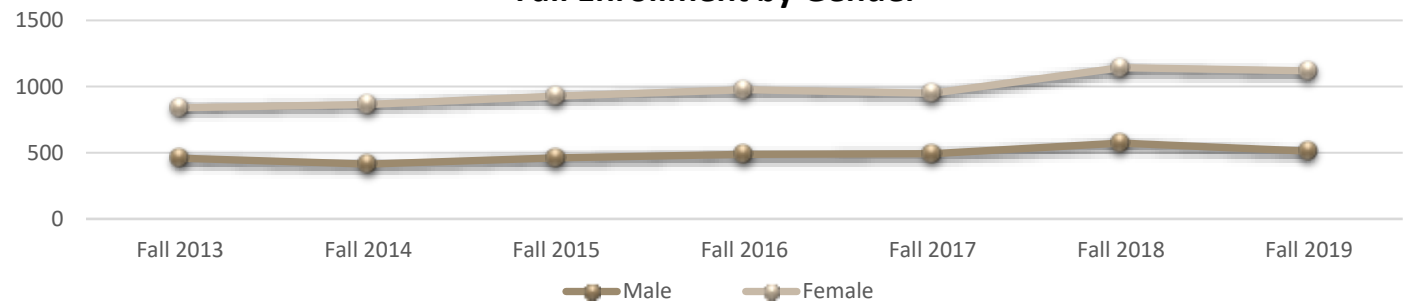
Fall Enrollment: New Students



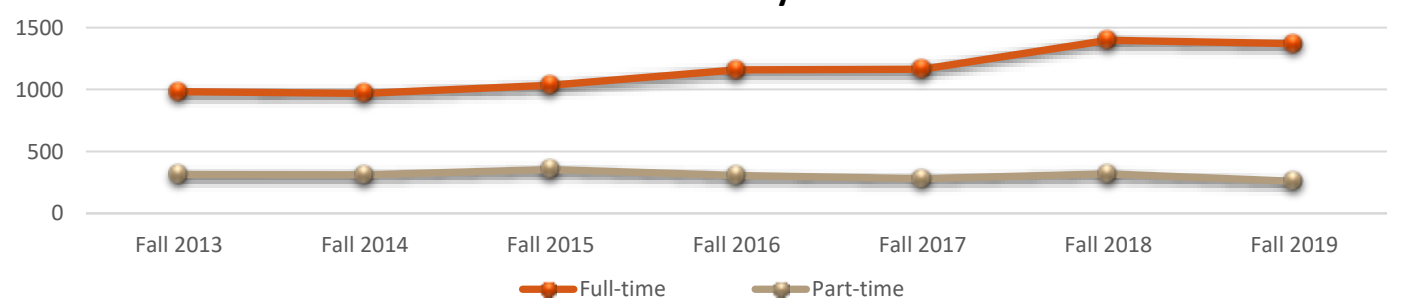
Fall Enrollment and FTE

Fall Enrollment by Status

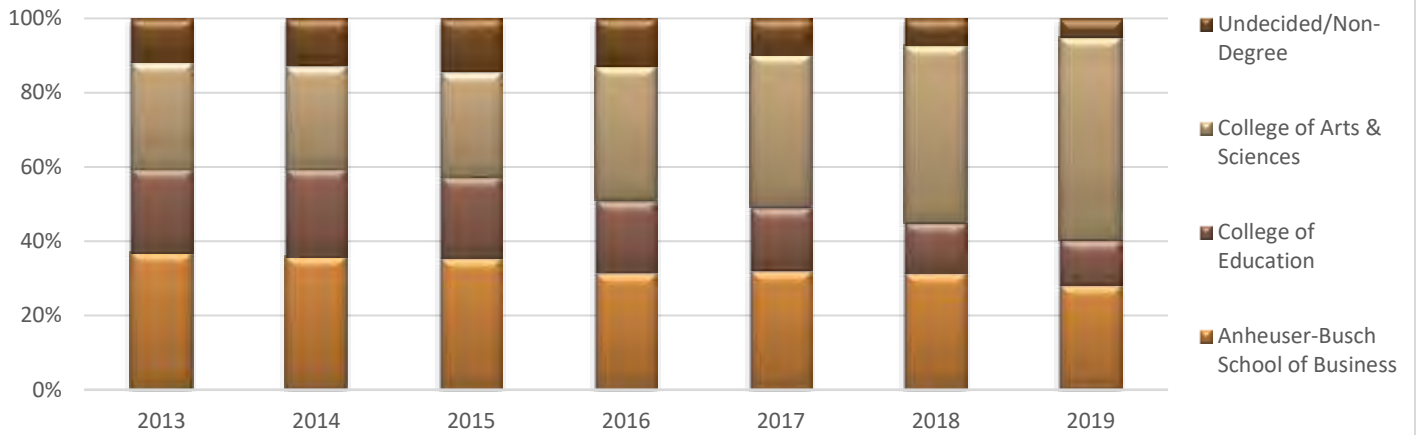

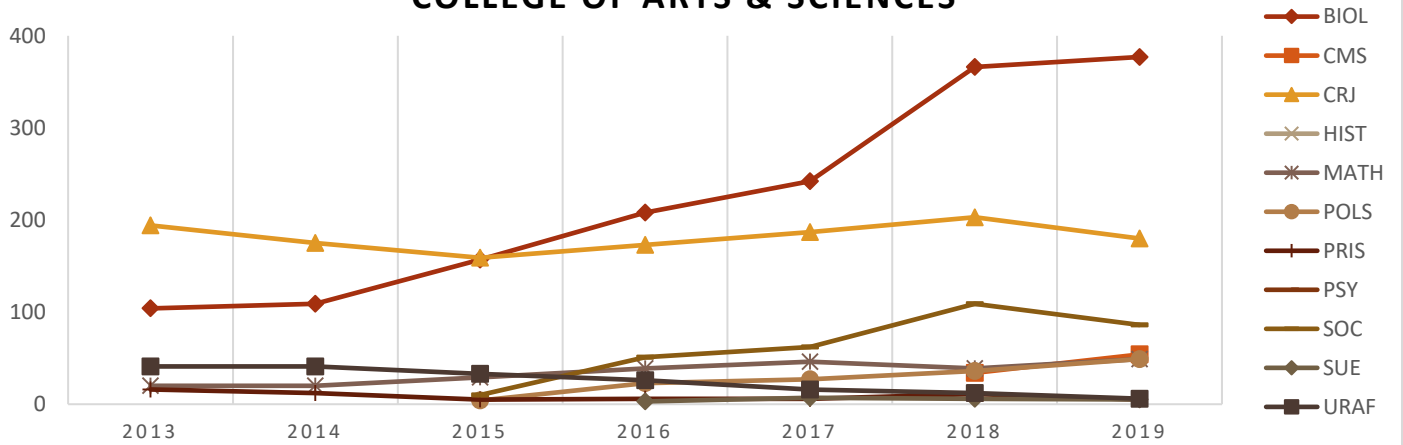

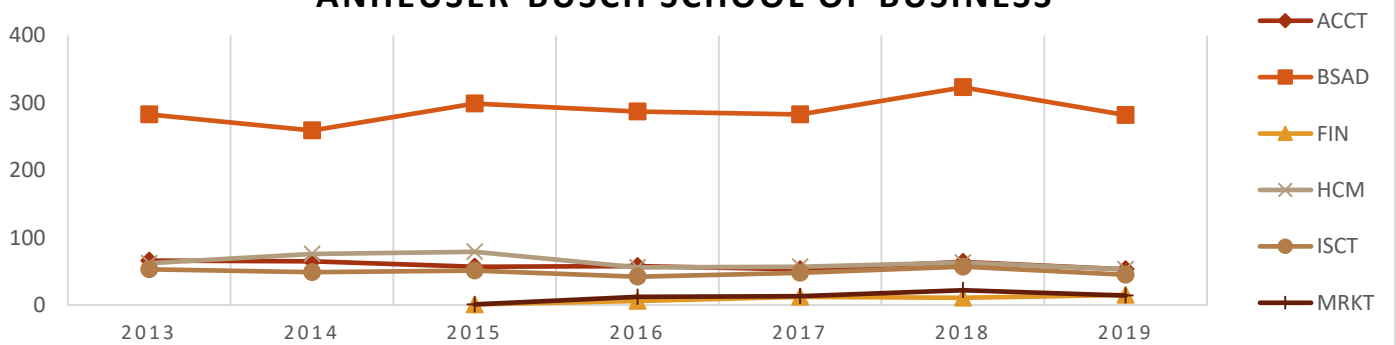
Enrollment Breakdown by College/School



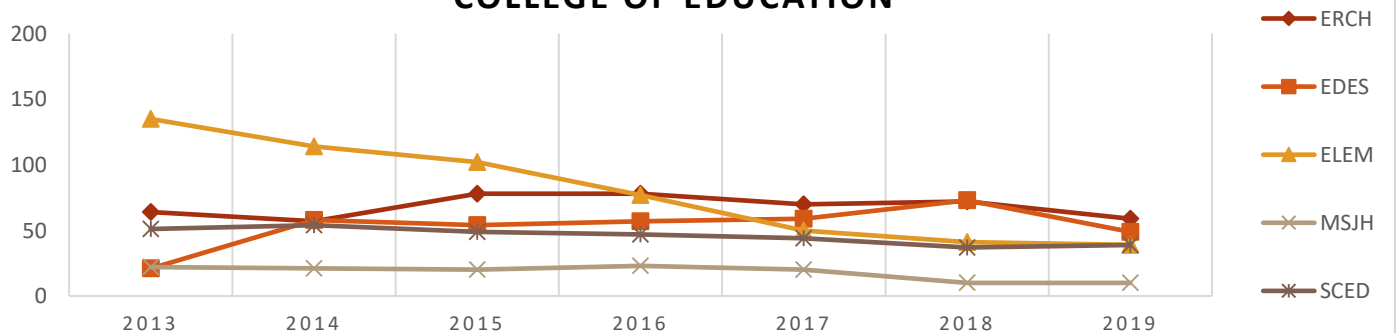

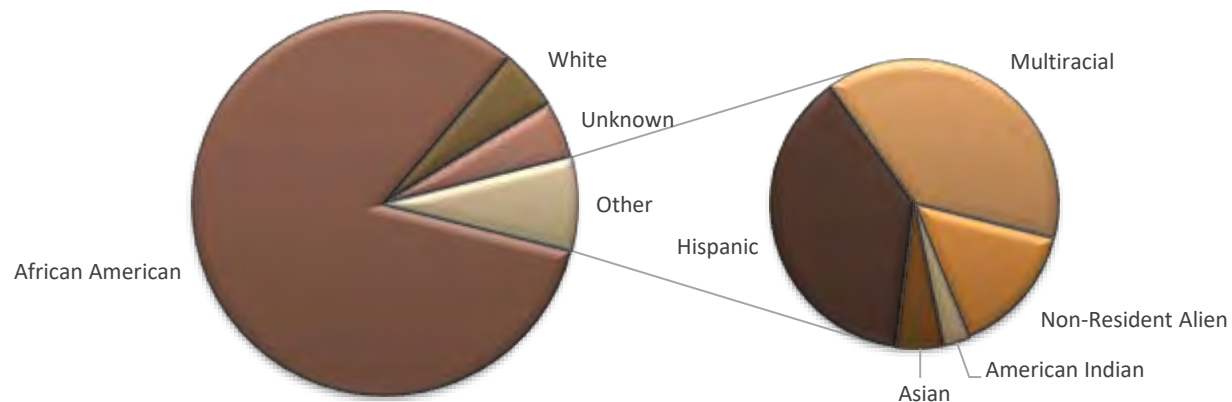

Fall 2019 Student Body by Race/Ethnicity

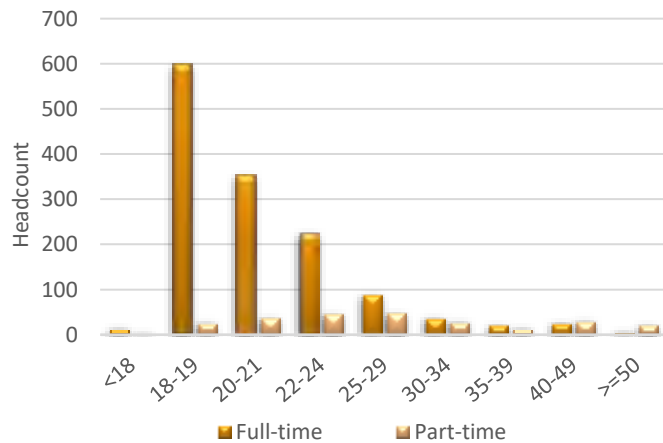

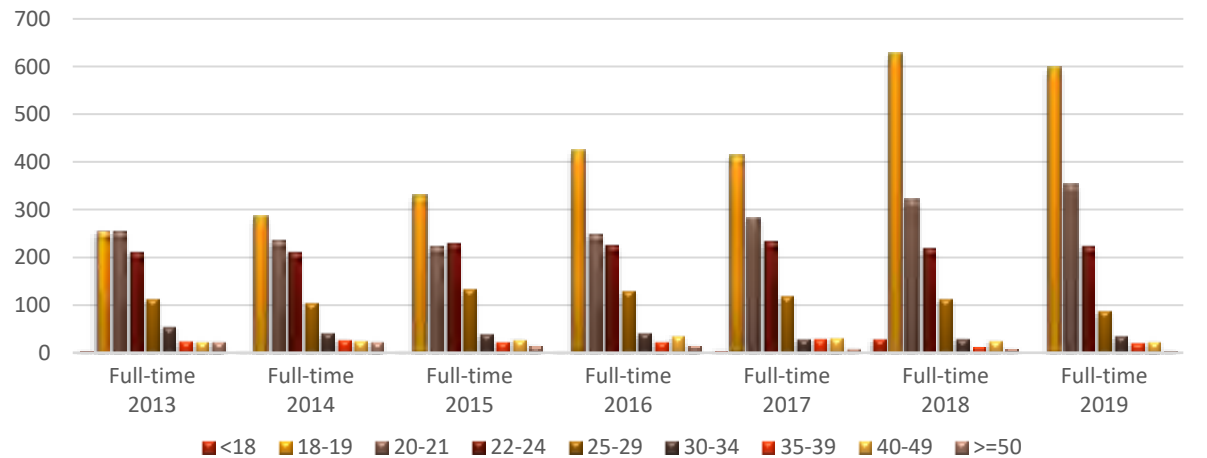

Retention: First-time, Full-time Freshmen

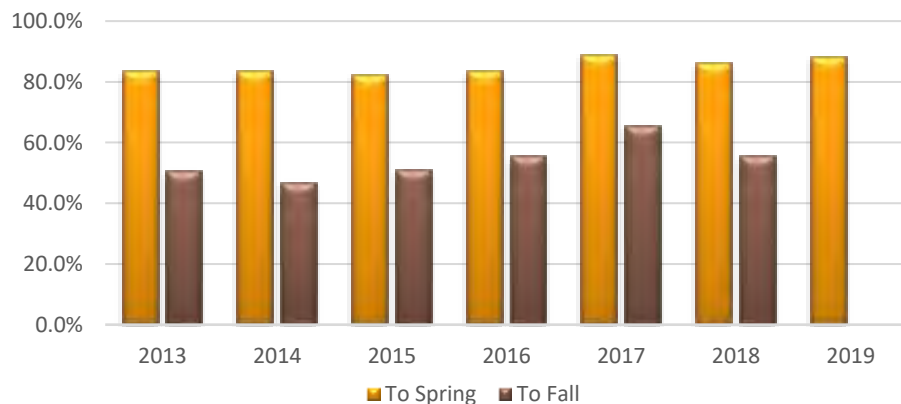

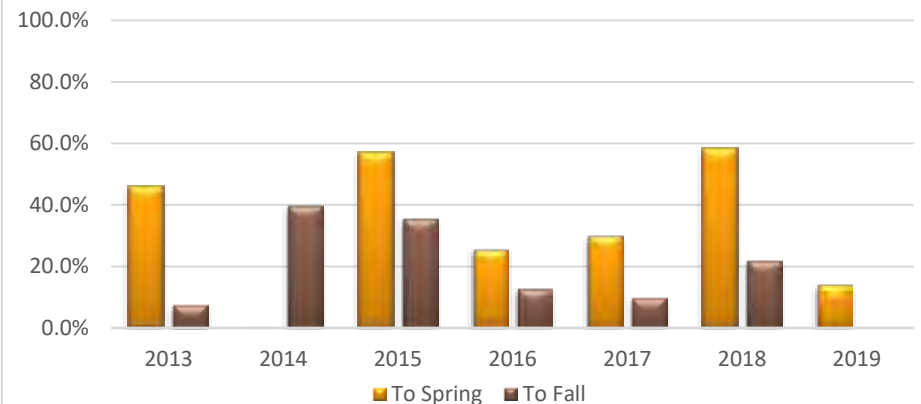

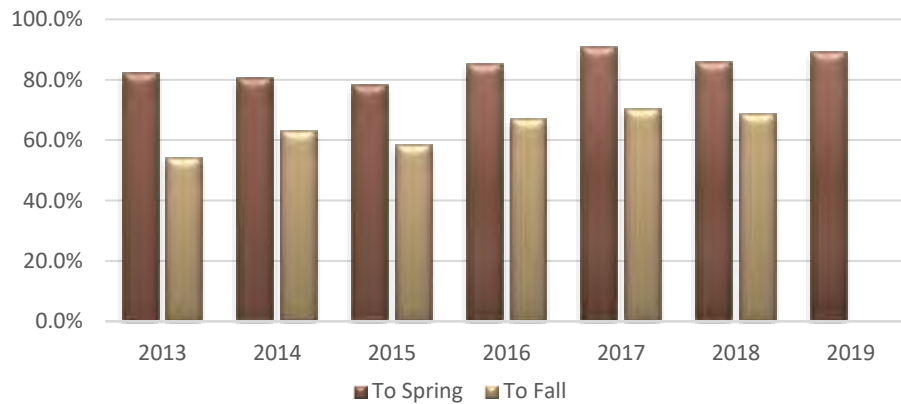

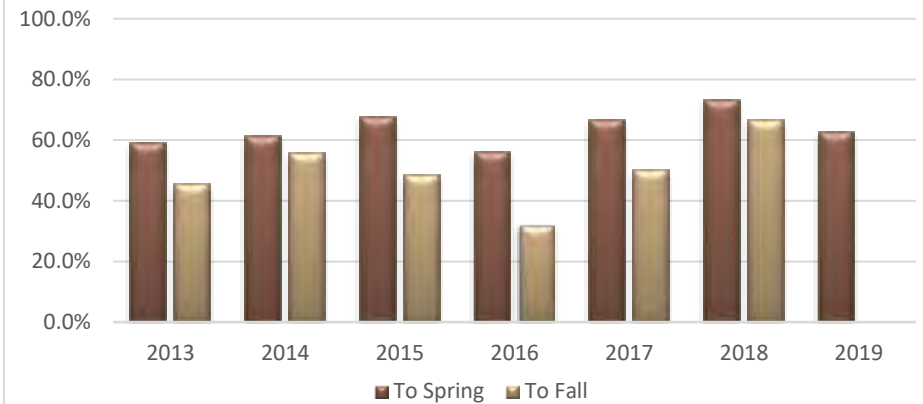

First-time, Full-time Transfer Retention

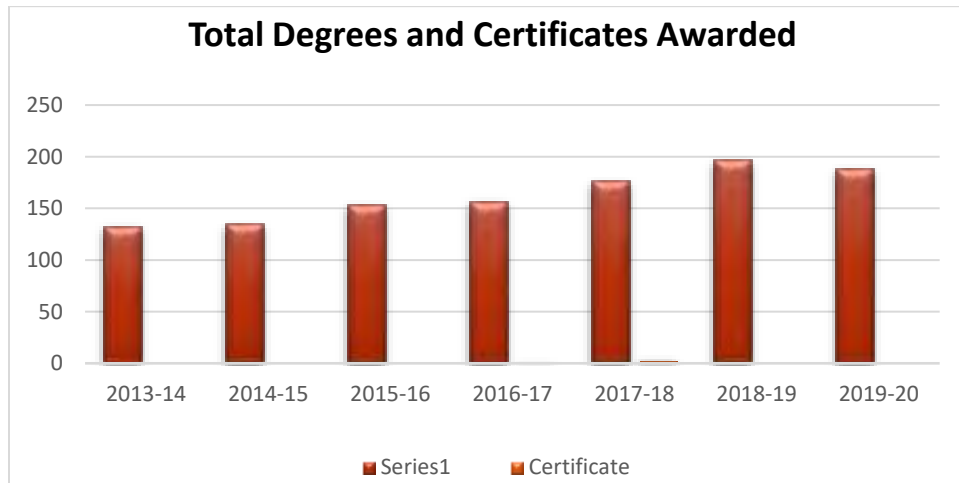


First-time, Part-time Transfer Retention

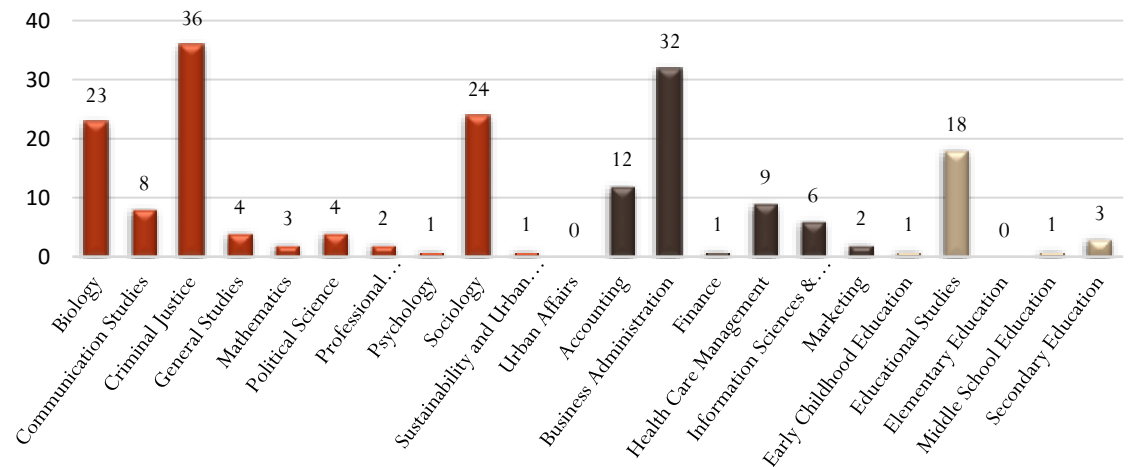
Degrees Conferred by Division



2019-2020 Bachelor Degrees Awarded by College



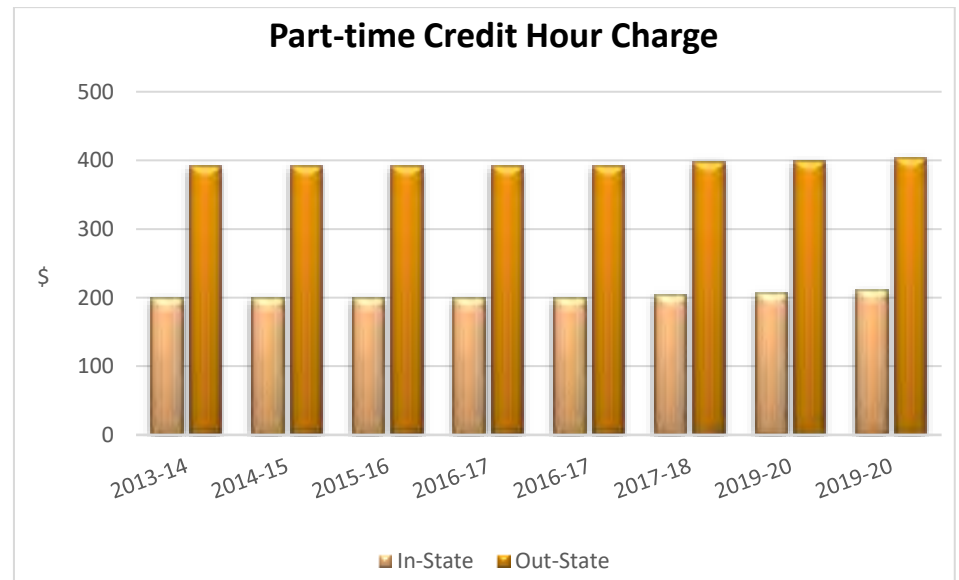
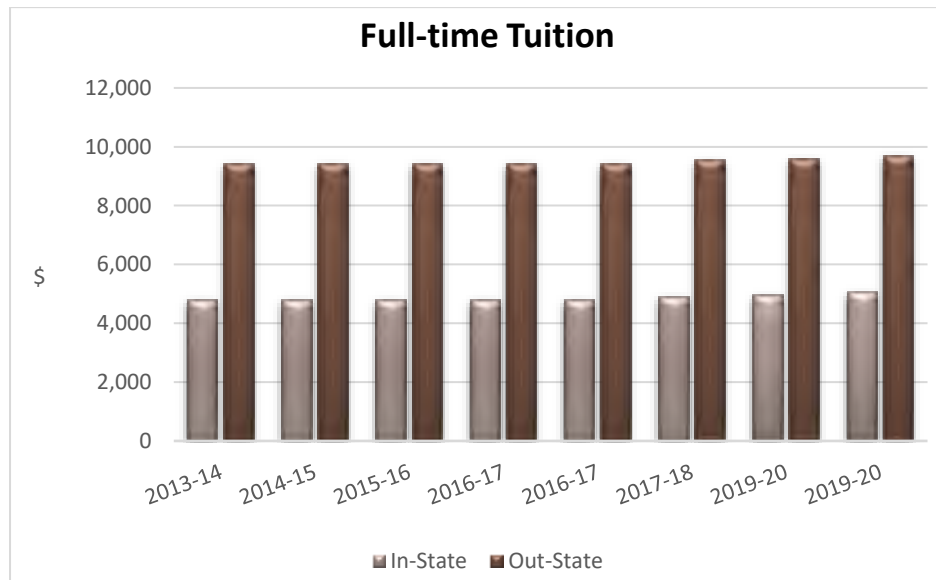

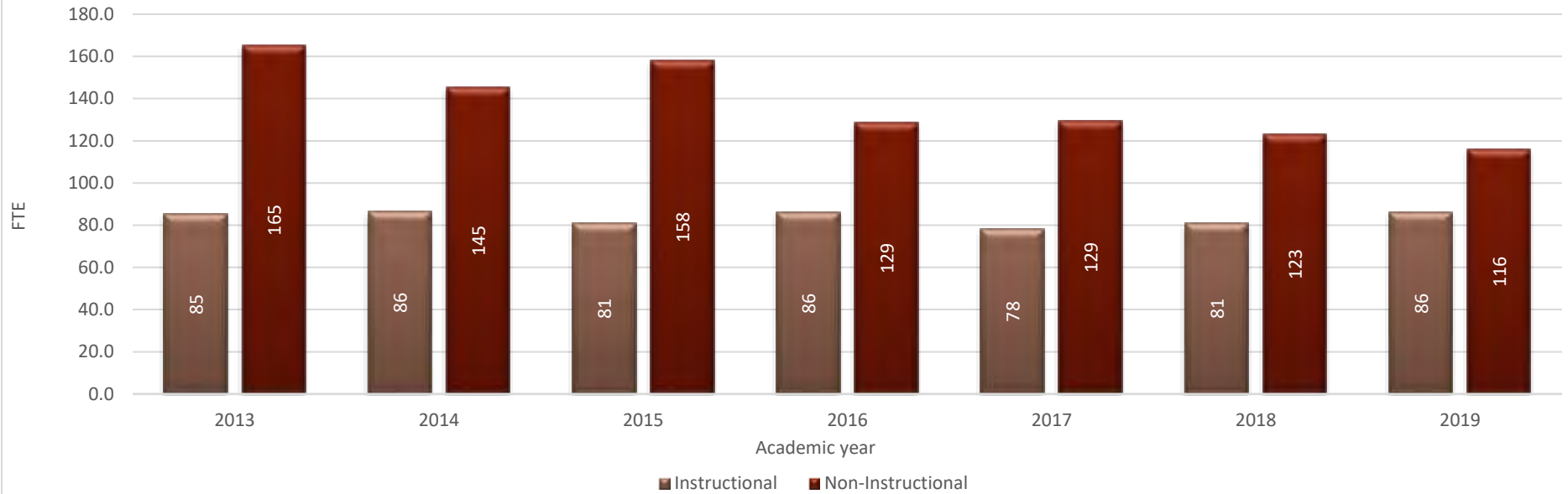

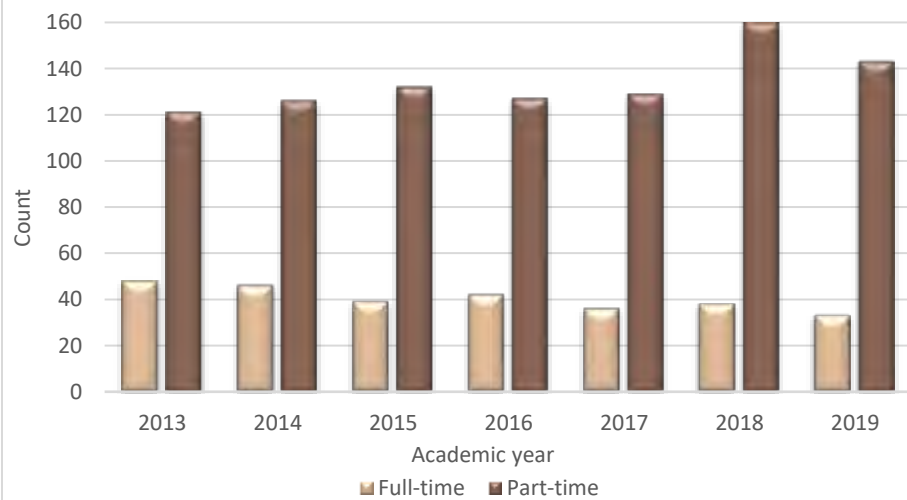

All Employee FTE

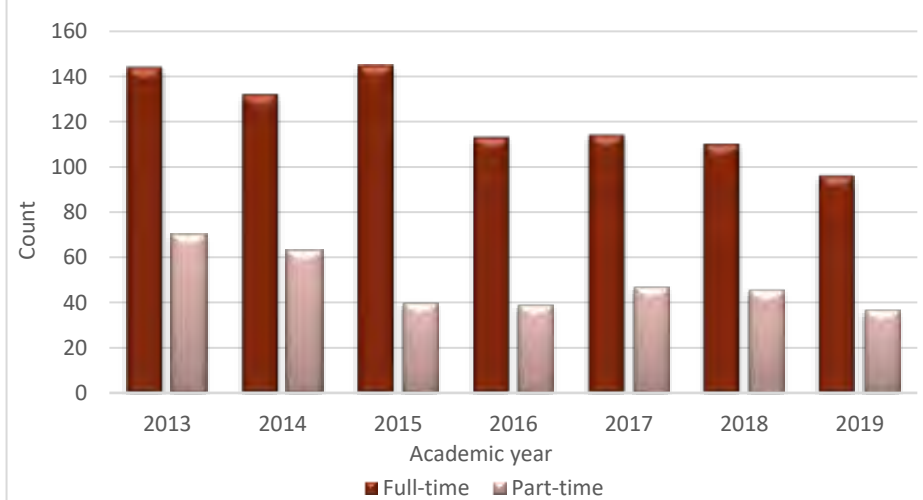
