Re: Campus COVID-19 Update & Testing Reminder

Below is a snapshot of reported COVID-19 cases at Harris-Stowe State University as of Thursday, October 15, 2020.

- 0 reported cases of COVID-19 among students
- 0 reported cases of COVID-19 among faculty
- 3 reported cases of COVID-19 among staff

Please note that these numbers reflect the number of reported cases since our last COVID-19 Campus Update on Thursday, October 1, 2020.

As a friendly reminder, the University is requiring all students and employees who will be on campus at any time during the remainder of the Fall 2020 semester to provide a negative COVID-19 test result to HSSU before **Friday, October 23, 2020**.

Employees can meet this requirement by taking a COVID-19 test at a facility covered by our insurance provider or a licensed provider. Employees should submit their results to Human Resources in person or by email at hr@hssu.edu.

Students may obtain a COVID-19 test from a licensed provider and provide documentation to the HSSU Office of Student Health Services at healthservices@hssu.edu or participate in free on-campus testing on October 21 or 22. Testing will be conducted by appointment only. Students can make appointments at www.hssu.edu/c19OctTest.
